Naming right assets for each seat are valid through a twenty (20) year period, the standard life of the seat.



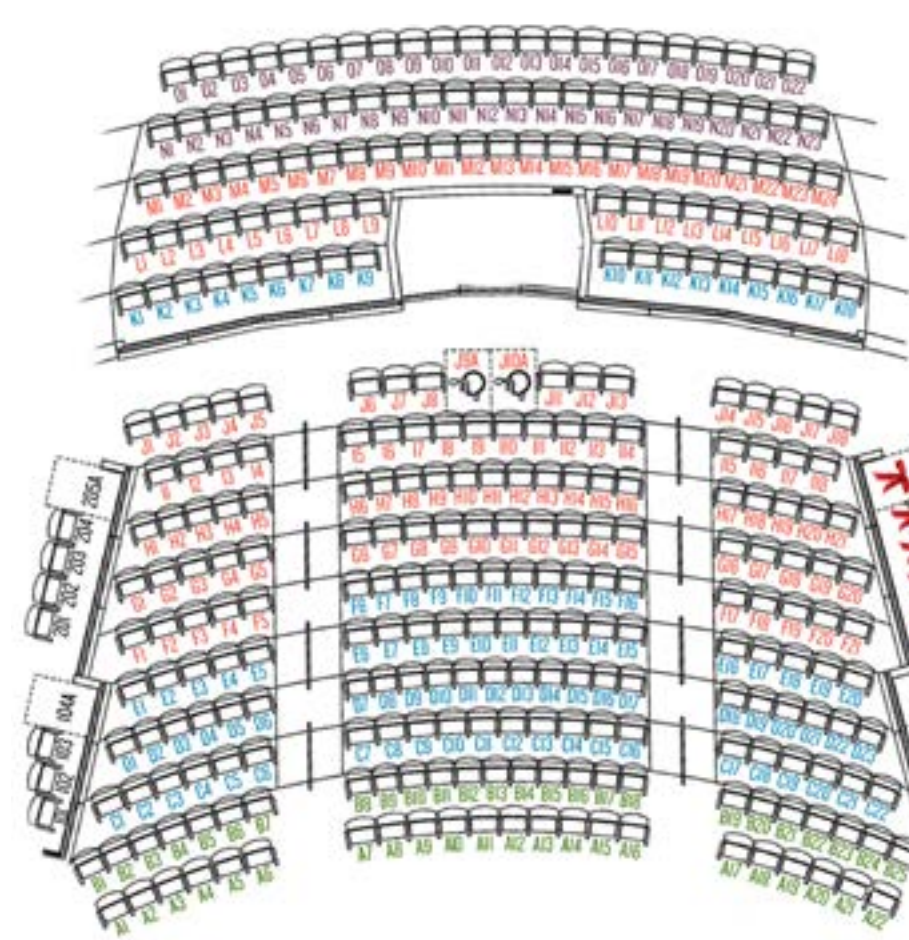

FIELD HALL MODEL SEATS

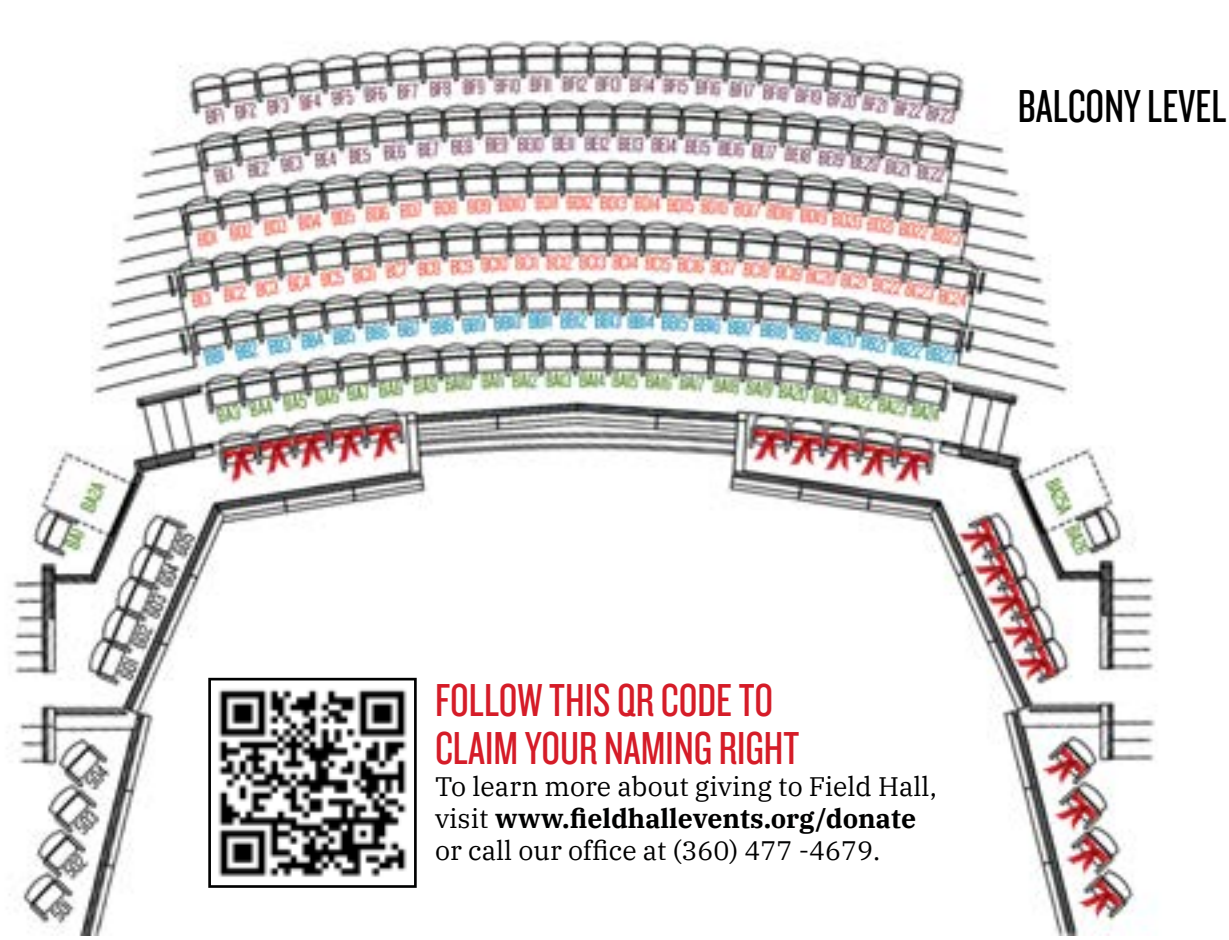
