Over Hire/Stagehands and Lighting/Sound Techs

JOB SUMMARY

Field Arts & Events Hall is seeking responsible and reliable individuals with interest or experience in theater, looking to join our over hire team. This is a fast-paced theater and event production environment which includes assisting with lighting, sound, set and backstage support. This position will report to the Technical Director and Production Manager.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Under the direction of the Technical Director and Production Manager, Over Hire Stagehands and Lighting/Sound Techs will work together in the essential duties and responsibilities, which include the following. Other duties, responsibilities, and activities may change or be assigned.

- Set up theater and production events;
- Run theater and production events;
- Strike Theater and production events;
- Building stages;
- Hauling touring and rental equipment;
- Hanging and focusing lights;
- Building portable audio systems;
- Running lighting and audio consoles during performances;
- Assisting in general theater maintenance

The Over Hire position works in a freelance capacity and will be contacted by the Technical Director for their availability to work an on-call basis. There are no minimum or maximum number of hours assigned or required, the position is flexible with other employment or projects.

Qualifications

- Experience working in a theater;
- Experience running audio consoles, working with mics, and audio cable;
- Experience running lighting consoles and adjusting lighting plots;
- Interest in cross training and learning various systems;

Requirements

- Must be able to work weekends and evenings;
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Must be able to stand and sit for long periods of time

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- Must be able to follow instruction and work independently
- Must have great communication skills and have strong interpersonal skills.
