ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Under the direction of the Food & Beverage Manager, Bartenders will work together in the essential duties and responsibilities, which include the following. Other duties, responsibilities, and activities may change or be assigned.

- Promote, work, and act in a manner consistent with the mission of Field Arts & Events Hall.
- Prepares and serves drinks to guests in accordance with established standards. Ensures standard measures are utilized when mixing and pouring drinks.
- Manages and maintains the quality, consistency, and portion controls for all dispensed drinks.
- Maintains current knowledge of drink recipes, service techniques and bar terminology.
- Processes guest's payments, using proper accounting and cash handling, adhering to all revenue handling policies and procedures.
- Ensures attractive, consistent, presentation of beverages.
- Provides timely and courteous follow – through on all client, guest, and team member requests.
- Maintain proper inventory stock/PAR of all products and supplies needed for service in assigned stations.
- Maintain a safe and clean environment for guests and fellow associates.
- Adheres to and maintains standards for guest interactions, personal grooming, sanitation, and safe food handling.
- Follows all safety procedures. Reports all unsafe conditions immediately. Ensures all equipment is used only as intended.

- Working knowledge of applicable liquor laws and regulations.
- Must possess good communication skills and the ability to speak effectively and interact well with guests and team members.

- Must be able to work weekends and evenings;
- Must be able to bend, stoop, lift and carry items weighing up to but not limited to 50 pounds on a regular basis.
- Must be able to occasionally push/pull up to but not limited to 75 pounds.
- Must be able to stand and or walk for long periods of time.
- Must be able to perform simple grasping, fine manipulation, overhead reaching, and repetitive hand and arm movements frequently. Must have great communication skills and have strong interpersonal skills.
