How You Benefit from a Legacy Gift

Depending on the type of gift and how it is structured, you may realize meaningful advantages such as:

- Fulfilling personal values and charitable aspirations
- Lowering annual income taxes through charitable deductions
- Bypassing capital gains taxes on the donation of appreciated assets held long-term
- Securing lifetime income for yourself and/or designated loved ones
- Enhancing financial flexibility by increasing your available income
- Removing donated assets from your taxable estate, potentially reducing estate taxes
- Streamlining the administration of your estate and easing the burden on your heirs

Ways to Make a Legacy Gift:

- **Bequests** Include Field Hall in your will or living trust. You can designate a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your estate, or the remainder after other obligations are met.
- **Retirement Plan Assets** Name Field Hall as a beneficiary of your IRA, 401(k), or other qualified retirement accounts. This may reduce estate and income taxes for your heirs.
- **Life Insurance** Name Field Hall as a full or partial beneficiary of a life insurance policy you no longer need.
- **Donor Advised Funds (DAF)** Recommend a gift from your DAF now or name Field Hall as a successor beneficiary to your fund.
- **Charitable Trusts** Establish a Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT) or Charitable Lead Trust (CLT) to provide income for yourself or others while supporting Field Hall in the long-term.
- **Gifts of Real Estate** Donate residential, commercial, or undeveloped property. This can be done outright or via estate plans, potentially offering tax advantages.
- **Appreciated Securities** Give stocks, bonds, or mutual funds directly to Field Hall. You may avoid capital gains tax and receive a charitable deduction.
- **Payable/Transfer on Death Designations (POD/TOD)** Add Field Hall as a beneficiary to your bank or investment accounts for a straightforward transfer at death.
- **Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)** Make a gift to Field Hall in exchange for fixed lifetime payments. After your lifetime, the remaining balance supports our mission.
- **Retained Life Estate** Deed your home to Field Hall while continuing to live in it for life. This can offer immediate tax benefits while maintaining personal use.

- **Endowed Funds** Create a named endowment through your estate to support a specific program or area of Field Hall in perpetuity.
- **Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs)** If you're age 70½ or older, you can donate directly from your IRA to Field Hall, potentially reducing your taxable income.

Each of these options can be tailored to fit your financial goals, family considerations, and philanthropic vision. Always consult with your financial or legal advisor to determine the best strategy for your situation.
